\$12 per seam (up to 70")

\$15 per seam (over 70")

Seams pressed open & selvages trimmed

quilt top (old or new)

Prices quoted per job

To calculate square inches:

Measure quilt top length & width.

Multiply length by width.

Example: 81Wx96L=7776 square"

To calculate linear inches:

Measure quilt top width & length

Add width + length, multiply by 2

Example: 81W+96L=177x2=354"

All 3 layers separate- no basting or pins please

Top:

____ loose threads trimmed

____ well pressed

____ seam direction checked

____ no wavy borders

____ squared corners

____ back stitch all outside seams

____ all repairs done, no open seams

____ mark "TOP" with safety pin

____ no embellishments please

Backing:

____ **You can purchase from Pat**

(108" wide "BROADS" 100% cotton)

____ no sheets please

____ "printy" to hide threads

____ colors match quilt top

____ selvages trimmed or clipped

____ 1/2" seams pressed open

____ well pressed

____ ends straightened & squared

____ mark "TOP" with safety pin

____ at least 6" larger than top

Batting:

____ **You can purchase from Pat**

____ proper type for your quilt

____ wash & dry cotton & blend
