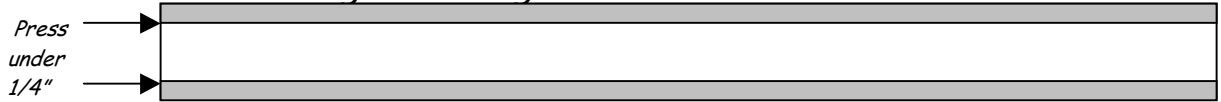


HANGLES:

- From main fabric cut a piece of fabric 11"x36". See cutting diagram.
- Fuse interfacing onto back of fabric.
- Cut into 2 pieces that measure 5"x36".
- Press under 1/4" along both long sides of handles.



- Press handles in half, lengthwise, with the right sides out.
- Measure width of handle and subtract 1/8". Cut 2 pieces of batting that measurement by 36". Lay batting strip inside handle. If you want extra padding, use 2 layers of batting.
- Topstitch lengthwise, very close to both long edges beginning at open edge. Add 2 more lines of stitching in center of handle.
